1. Three years of one foreign language in high school course work (official high school transcripts are acceptable)
2. The equivalent of an intermediate level foreign language course. At CSUSB, this is a '103' foreign language course, or it's equivalent taken elsewhere (official transcripts are acceptable).
3. Bilingual credit will be given to a native language by submission of letter of validation from clergy, co-worker, school administrator, or instructor.

1. Statistics – MATH 305
2. Developmental Psychology – PSYC 201
3. One integrative capstone course that meets the Multicultural/Gender requirement in the General Education program.

Applicants are required to complete the ATI-TEAS pre-admission examination. A test booklet may be purchased in the Coyote Bookstore. Testing times and days will be available on the Nursing Web Site throughout the application process.
